KING LEGION AUXILIARY

For any of you who have dark colored worsted weight yarn and want to make soldiers’ hats, here is the pattern: Using size 10 needles, cast on 76 stitches, K2P2 for 6 inches. Row 1: K2 tog. for a row; Row 2: K next row; repeat last 2 rows until 5 stitches are left, run yarn through to close circle. Sew up back seam.
